
PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT

Accused Party or Parties: Washington, Kenterrian

The undersigned affiant gives the statement of facts recited herein as being true to the best of his or her knowledge and belief and submits such statement of facts in support of probable cause for detention to be considered by the judicial officer conducting the pretrial release inquiry:

On 9/15/16 at 0157 hours Officers were called to the area of Race St. in reference to approximately 3-6 shots being heard. Dispatch received several calls in reference to the shots being fired. At 0221 hours Officer Loggains was on a traffic stop at the intersection of Johnson Ave. and Airport Rd. when a car pulled up to the stop and advised that the passengers inside the vehicle had been shot. Officer Loggains noticed that two of the male passengers had been shot in their heads. The victims were taken to NEA Baptist Hospital, and identified as Brianna Meagher, Joshua Cherrith, Eichiie Moore, and Dequantez Lawless. Meagher stated that she had driven the other three victims to a house on Race St. Meagher stated that while at the house two men came out of the house and began shooting at them and their car as they were driving away. Victim Joshua Cherrith stated that he and the other victims went to the house for a dice game. Cherrith stated that he went into the house and was met by a Thomas Razor. Cherrith stated that while talking to Razor inside the residence Razor struck him in the head and then pulled a gun out to rob him. Cherrith stated that he and Razor began fighting over the gun. Cherrith said that a second suspect came up and put a gun underneath Cherrith's chin and told him to give up the money or he would kill him. Cherrith was then robbed of \$600.00. Cherrith stated that the second suspect he only knew through facebook as "Lit Jay Dashoota". The profile was pulled up and the second suspect was identified as Kenterrian Washington. Cherrith said that the only thing he knew about Washington was that he had shot someone in Blytheville recently. Cherrith said that he then left the residence and tried to get the homeowner to get his money back to him. At which time both suspects exited the residence and told the victims to leave. The victims began leaving and the victims stated that both suspects began shooting at them and the car as they were leaving. Two of the victims were struck in the head by bullets fired from the suspects. Washington was noticed leaving a residence on Cotton St. on 9/15/16 and was taken into custody. While being taken into custody Washington had a Ruger 9 mm semi automatic pistol in his waistband. The gun was similar to the one used in the shooting by Razor. Washington was then interviewed. During his interview Washington stated that he was at the house and he had shot at the car. Washington said that Cherrith was trying to rob Razor and he came up to Cherrith and put a gun to Cherrith. Washington said that when he and Razor came out of the house they told the victims to leave. Washington said that one of the victims fired a shot at them so he and Razor began shooting at the car. None of the evidence on scene or witness statements show that a shot was fired at the suspects.


