If the investigation shows that the complaint is unfounded or that the officer acted properly, the matter will be closed.

**CAUTION:** The Jonesboro Police Department takes allegations of employee misconduct seriously; consequently, if the investigation reveals the complaint was made maliciously, in bad faith, or with knowledge that the accusation was false, action shall be taken, whenever possible, to prosecute for a false report.
