Facts Constituting Reasonable Cause

On the 23rd day of August 2025, police responded to a disturbance at a home in the 900 block of N. 4th Street. There, a victim reported an altercation had occurred between them and their father, potential defendant Carl Morgan. The victim reported that Morgan came after them and pulled a knife.

A second victim reported that Morgan injured them with the knife during the altercation with the first victim. Police noted the second victim had injuries in two different areas of their body; one injury being a small laceration on their wrist while the second injury was a small puncture wound on their back.

Witnesses in the home corroborated both victims' reports. Additionally, there were seven juveniles present inside the room in the home where the disturbance took place.

I hereby certify that the above are facts that were found to exist during my investigation and would establish probable cause for arrest.
