**RESTRAINING ORDER**

The Respondent, Dan Stidham, appears by and through his/her attorney, Zach Morrison. Whereupon, this cause having been reached upon the call of the calendar, is submitted to the Court upon the Petitioner's Petition, due service of process upon the Respondent in the manner prescribed by law, testimony of the parties and counsel, from all of which the Court, being well and sufficiently advised as to all matters of law and fact arising herein, find:

1. That this Court has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter hereto.
2. That the Respondent shall have no contact with the Petitioner, either directly or indirectly, for a period of Ten (10) years. The Respondent shall not email, make phone calls, send text messages, send message through third parties,

make contact through any form of social media or have any other means of contact with the Petitioner prior to the expiration of this Order.

3. That the Respondent is restrained and enjoined from going to the Petitioner's residence during the pendency of this Order.

4. This Order is being entered in place of a Final Order of Protection.


5. This Order is enforceable by the Court's contempt powers.

**IT IS SO ORDERED.**




